the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto

W. D. Ridgeway, the following described real estate, to wit:
all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the
State and County aforesaid, in Dunklin Township, containing
fifty-two and one half ($52\frac{1}{2}$) acres, more or less, lying on the
Plumerton Road and bounded by lands of B. P. Gray, J.
Malone, W. D. Ridgeway and Stone, and being a part of the
tract of land conveyed to W. A. Black by S. B. Huff by deed
bearing date 2nd day of January 1911 and recorded in
