Assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate,
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the
road to Spartanburg and Greenville, about five miles from Green-
ville Court House, containing forty-three acres, more or less, and
bearing the following lines, metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning
at a stake 3x0 and running thence N. 3 1/4 W. 21.20 chs. to a
stone 3x0; thence along the public road S. 80 1/2 W. 26.50 chs. to a
stake (P. C. gone) 3x0 substituted; thence S. 46 1/4 E. 10.00 chs. to a
stake 3x0; thence N. 43 3/4 E. 3.17 chs. to a stone 3x0; thence S. 46 1/4 E.
6.34 chs. to a stone 3x0; thence N. 43 3/4 W. 3.17 chs. to a stone 3x0,
thence S. 46 1/4 E. 8.00 chs. to two maples on the bank of creek;

ville, in Greenville, about 5 miles from the City of Greenville, on the east
side of the Augusta Road, and on the west side of Reedy River, having the
following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the
center of the Augusta Road, and running thence along line of property of
J. C. Wilford N. 26° 30' E. six hundred and seventy-three and five tenths
(673.5) feet to a stone; thence N. 50° E. eleven hundred and five (1105) feet to a
stake; thence along line of lot of Albert Wilson S. 31° E. three hundred and
thirty (330) feet to a stake; thence N. 52° E. two hundred and five (205)
