NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That S. J. Dalton of the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two thousand, six hundred, thirty-five and DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. W. Hambrill.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said G. W. Hambrill, his Heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Greenville Township, State and aforesaid and having the following lines and bounds according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated December 1916, to-wit: Beginning at a stake in an old road which formerly crossed Saluda River at Shoe Station and running thence by a new line S. 11 W. 445 feet (passing through a pine tree 14.5 feet from the beginning corner) to a small pine tree; thence S. 2.34 W. 842 feet to a poplar tree on the bank of a branch; thence, down the branch as a line to a sycamore tree on the bank of Saluda River (the new up the meanders of Saluda River being in S. 46 W. 200 feet); the next up the meanders of Saluda River 2325 feet to a small sycamore tree in the center of old road above mentioned, thence W. 186.45 E. 173 feet to a bend; thence S. 39 E. 186.45 feet to a bend; thence S. 58 W. 157.5 feet to a bend; thence S. 59.54 E. 254.5 feet to a bend; thence S. 58 W. 157.5 feet to a bend; thence S. 36.36 E. 192.5 feet to the beginning corner, and containing fifty-two and seven-tenths (.527) acres, more or less, and being a portion of the same land bought by me from Simon Bishop and confirmed by him to me by deed dated February 20th 1877 and recorded in the office of Greenville for Greenville County in Book 47, at page 614, which deed is for one hundred and five (105) acres, more or less.
