(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said N. P. Mc Gee, all that lot of land in Ward St. City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, be an alley leading from Wilkins Street and Sullivan Street; Beginning at a stake corner of Maxwell's land, thence along line of Maxwell and T. W. Davis patch 76-51 feet, two hundred fifty five and 3/19 (255.3) feet to a stake in a branch, corner of J. C. Milford's property, thence down said branch along line of Milford south 6-0 East two hundred fifty three and 3/10 (253.3) feet to a stake on edge of branch, thence North 84-48 East one hundred twenty and 9/10 (120.9) feet to an iron pipe on an alley, thence along alley North 28-29 East two hundred nineteen feet to the point of the beginning according to a survey by R.
