THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, County of Greenville. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, A. J. Phillips and H. A. Phillips in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred (\$900.00) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Abraham H. Najas:

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Abraham H. Najas, the following described real estate: All that piece parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake at a point on the West side of Hodie Avenue 102 feet North from the intersection of Hodie Avenue and Pendleton Road and running thence along Hodie Avenue in a North-ly direction 34 feet to a stake; thence in a Westerly direction with line of Hodie Avenue 50 feet; thence in a southerly direction along Hodie Avenue 50 feet to an iron pin; thence in an Easterly direction with line of H. A. Phillips lot 50 feet to the beginning corner on Hodie Avenue. The principal part of the above described being made up of a lot conveyed to A. J. Phillips by B. E.
