and also in consideration of the sum of Three DOLLARS
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the said Nathaw Carl Bright and
Annie C. Bright

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto
the said Nathaw Carl Bright and Annie C. Bright, all that certain
piece, parcel or tract of Land situate, lying and being in the
State and County aforesaid, as follows: Beginning at a stone
of Reubens Sudiths running with the Dill survey to Post oak
corner, dead end down on Frank Balw's corner thence with
Balw's line in a North direction far enough to make a corner
thence parallel with the Dill line back opposite the Sudiths
corner to make (17) seven tenths acres lying broadside to the Dill
tract of land, containing 1.7 seven tenths acres more or less.

But it is expressly understood that I, the said Mary P.
Bright, and to have the sole control of the tract of land
herein to be conveyed, and the full benefit of all the rents
issues etc. arising from the within tract of land hereby
conveyed during my natural life, and in no event
shall this deed of conveyance take effect during my
natural life.
