 A certain tract piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in State and County aforesaid on Branch waters of Gap Creek of North Fork of Saluda River beginning on a rock corner on the Branch thence nearly West a straight line into the Callahan line to a white oak near the top of the shoals on Gap Creek, thence nearly N. E. with said Branch to a mahogany near the ford of said Branch, thence nearly E. a straight line to a rock corner on the Branch, thence from the rock corner down said Branch to the beginning rock corner, containing five acres more or less, being a part of the Old Jacob Pruitt place, Deed bearing date Mar. 21, 1904

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Henry F. Woodson, all my right title and undivided interest, same being one-tenth interest in, of and to all that piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Rocky Fork Branch waters of Saluda river, containing fifty-two and one-half acres, beginning at a stone at the road and running thence N. or N. 30.50 chains to a stone in the road where Rocky Fork crosses said road thence the road line to a stone in said road thence N. 88 W. 17.00 chains to a stone, thence S. 2 1/2 E. to a stone on the road near the home of Emily Jordan, deceased, distance 41.00 chains, thence the road the line to the beginning, bounded by lands of H.
