 in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500) Dollars DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. W. Collins

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

L. W. Collins all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, State and County aforesaid, containing twenty-five (25) acres, more or less, adjoining lands now owned by or formerly belonging to B. P. Langley, B. E. Batson, and others and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning on Stone B. E. Batson's corner, and running thence S. 13 3/4 W. 15.83 to a stone corn, thence S. 9 1/2 E. 8.75 to a black gum corn, thence S. 80 E. 18.00 to a stone corn, thence N. 30 W. 32.00 to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to me by M. C. Stokes by her deed dated March 2 1910 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 28, page 114.
