NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Lena Harrison
in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

John H. Harrison, Jr.
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

John H. Harrison, Jr. his heirs and assigns.
All my right, title and interest in and to all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County South Carolina and being the same upon which said John H. Harrison, Jr. now resides; Beginning at a stone near the middle of Jenkins Bridge Road and running thence N. 33 1/2 W. 34.80 to large P.O. thence N. 60 1/2 W. 6.45 to stone, thence S. 76 W. 31.61 to stone, thence S. 60 1/2 E. 40.80 to stone on Jenkins Bridge Road, thence N. 54 3/4 E. 12.36 to stone on road, thence N. 37 E. 3.72 to beginning corner, and containing a whole one hundred acres more or less, and being the same conveyed to S.E. and Richard Harrison by deed from D. P. Deinger, Master Nov. 5th 1894, said deed of conveyance being recorded in the Office R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book "B. B. B." at page 594, reference thereto being made for full description.

John H. Harrison, Jr. and his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
