NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A. D. Plumley of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifty ^{two} hundred DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

W. J. Lindsey of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. J. Lindsey all that piece or parcel of land lying and situated in Glassy Mountain Township County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having the following meters and bounds, beginning at a stone 3/4 on side of road, and running thence N. 38 W. 19.95 chains to a stone; thence with road S. 10. W. 4.68 to a stone, chestnut down, thence S. 4 E. 12.25 to a stone on the road, thence nearly South with F. M. Gosnell's line; 13 rods to a stone 3/4, thence nearly E 12.50 rods to a stone 3/4, thence 13 rods to a stone; thence down said road to the beginning corner, containing by estimate twelve (12) acres, and lying on both sides of public road, adjoining lands of Mrs. Harriet Stewart, F.
