in consideration of the sum of Four hundred (\$400.00) and Thirty DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by B. B. Bridwell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

B. B. Bridwell all that piece parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on headwaters of Musk Creek and in Saluda Township and has the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning in the old road near the Buncombe Road and near a spring on South side of old Road: thence S 77 25 3.50 chains to a branch, thence up said branch (6.00) as a line to a white oak (Down) thence S 45 1/2 28 14.60 chains to a stone; thence S 55 E 7.75 chains to a stake (Formerly a Chestnut) thence S 22 E 29.36 chains to a stake in a branch thence down branch as a line 5.42 chains to stake in branch, thence North 37.00 chains to the beginning corner, containing Forty (43) three acres more or less
