

Lella Campbell DEED TO John L. Campbell  
THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,  
County of Greenville

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Lella Campbell of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and 20/100 and other considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by John L. Campbell, my husband

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said John L. Campbell, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Highland Township, and having the following lines, meters and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stone, corner of G. W. Morrow's and F. L. Turner and running thence in a westerly direction to a stone corner of J. L. Campbell and F. L. Turner, and running thence in a northwesterly direction to a stone; thence nearly north to a wild-cherry tree, near a grave-yard; thence to a stone on the south bank of Middle Tyger River; thence down said river following its meanders thereof as a line to a stone on the G. W. Morrow line; thence with last mentioned line to the beginning corner, and bounded now by lands of G. W. Morrow, B. F. Henson, J. L. Campbell, et al, and containing twenty (20) acres, more or less; this being the same land conveyed to me by F. L. Turner by deed dated April 26th 1919 and not yet recorded.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said John L. Campbell, and his heirs and assigns, forever.

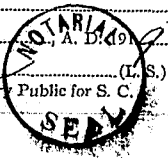

Campbell and his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
