NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, *E. M. Abharton* in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations*, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *Della R. Ellis*, DOLLARS,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *Della R. Ellis*, her heirs and assigns, all that lot of layed situate on the Northwest corner of Earle and Main Streets, in Ward one of the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin at Northwest corner of Earle and Main Streets and running thence with Main Street N. 19° E 19' 3" feet to a pin; thence N. 71° W. 10' 4" feet to a pin; thence in a southerly direction to Earle Street 75 feet from the corner of Main Street, thence with said Earle Street S. 83° E 01' 5" feet to the beginning corner being the land conveyed to me by *Mary A. Roberts* by deed dated the 24th day of May 1918, and recorded in Vol 35, page 336.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the Grantee herein does hereby assume and will pay a certain note and mortgage for \$ 5,000.00 with interest from this date according to the terms, said mortgage covering the aforesaid premises, and given to *E. M. Abharton* to the Bank of Commerce the 25th day of May, 1918 and recorded in Vol 36, page 232.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said *Della R. Ellis*, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my *Della R. Ellis*, her heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said *Della R. Ellis*, her heirs and assigns, forever.
