NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower, of the ^{city} of Greenville

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Forty-one hundred (\$4100.00) DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

H.M. and J.E. Crosswell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said H.M. and J.E. Crosswell, All those three lots of land situate just outside of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the east side of Augusta Road, known and designated as lots Nos. 5, 6, and 7, according to a survey of R.E. Dalton, May 1919 for Parrish & Gower, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on Augusta Road 495.3 feet from the intersection of Augusta Street and Prentiss Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with line of lot No. 4, N. 42-07 E. 170.7 feet to an iron pipe on a Fifteen foot alley; thence with said alley S. 53-03 E. 25 feet to an iron pipe; thence with said alley S. 59-28 E. 35.9 feet to an iron pipe; thence with said alley S. 71-45 E. 35 feet to an iron pipe; thence with said alley S. 73-24 E. 31.1 feet to an iron pipe; thence with said alley S. 62-34 E. 40.3 feet to an iron pipe; thence with said alley S. 56-28 E 21.2 feet to an iron pipe rear line lot No. 11, joint corner of lots Nos. 7 and 11; thence with rear line of lot No. 11, S. 42-07 W. 48.2 feet to an iron pipe on rear line of lot No. 8; thence with line of lot No. 8, S. 42-07 W. 173 feet to an iron pipe on Augusta Road; thence with Augusta Road N. 47-53 W. 180 feet to the point of beginning. Being a portion of the property conveyed to us by Cagle Park Company, by deed dated May 26th, 1919.

Subject, however, to the following restrictions, which are part of the consideration for this deed, and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the plat above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date of this deed, to-wit:

- (1) The property herein conveyed nor any part thereof shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to Negroes.
- (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor for anything which would constitute a nuisance.
- (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be re-cut nor subdivided so as to face any other direction than as shown on said plat.
- (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within thirty-five feet of the present line of Augusta Street. (5) No building costing less than Four thousand (\$4000) Dollars shall be erected upon said lot, other than out-buildings appurtenant to a dwelling.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

H.M. and J.E. Crosswell, their

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND We do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said H.M. and J.E. Crosswell, their

heirs and assigns, against ourselves and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
