 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. F. Harris of Greenville County
 in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other Considerations
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. R. Harris DOLLARS,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
G. R. Harris all that certain piece, parcel or tract of
 land situate lying and being in Grant Township, County
and State aforesaid about six miles south of the City of
Greenville, on the Fork Shoals Road, and containing five
and twenty eight one hundredths (5.28) acres, and
having the following metes and bounds.
 Beginning at iron pin in old Fork Shoals Road
 near the New Road and running thence S. 88° - 7' E.
 13-84 to white oak 3x N M thence N. 36 E 2.63 to stone
 3x at persimmon thence N. 36 W. 4.60 to stone at red oak,
 thence with Road N. 80 3/4 E 1.58 to bend, thence S 69 1/2
 W. 2.09 to pin in road, thence S 62 1/2 W. 10.50 to the
 beginning corner. Said land being a part of a tract of
 land conveyed to me by J. S. Ashmore by deed dated Dec.
