to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J W Norwood

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J W Norwood.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of South Main Street, beginning at an iron pin on line of South Main Street, which pin is the Southeast corner of lot No. 2 on the plat hereinafter referred to; thence N. 69-30 W 110 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with line of said alley S 20.30 W 66 feet to an iron pin on line of lot No. 6; thence with line of lot No. 6 S. 69.30 E. 110 feet to a point on line of South Main Street; thence with line of said Street N. 20-30 E. 66 feet to the beginning corner, being known as lots Nos 3, 4 and 5 on the plat of Markley Realty Company, made by J. E. Dirvine dated March 26th 1914, and marked M. B 261
