 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That G. Godfrey Calhoun of Greenville
in said County & in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of One hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. L. Calhoun

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said G. L. Calhoun, all my right, title and interest, and estate in and to the following described lots, pieces and parcels of land of which my son P. d. Calhoun died seized and possessed, in the City, County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described as follows. All that lot on the north side of Durbin St. known as lot #9 on a plat of lands of Mountain City Land and Improvement Co. recorded in Vol. 16, 76, 76, 29, 842, R. M. C. office for said County for the metes and bounds of which reference is hereby made to the deed by said Wm. Henry d. & S. S. to P. d. Calhoun dated Apr. 27, 1912 recorded in Vol. 9, 2, 2, at page 431. Also all that lot on extentions of Jenkins St. adjoining the corporate limits of the City of Greenville being one half-acre more or less, (less a portion sold by said P. d. Calhoun to Sullivan Franks 48x100 feet, Apr. 19, 1918, deed recorded in Vol. #35 at page 282) this being a portion of the same lot conveyed to said P. d. Calhoun by G. L. Calhoun by deed dated Sept. 17, 1909 to which reference is hereby made for more particular description
