(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Samuel Stallings, All that tract or parcel of land, situate
 lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina
 Beginning at a stone 3x0 m; thence N. 30 3/4 W. 5.30 to
 a Cherry 3x0 m, gone thence up Buck Horn Creek to a
 stone 3x0 m at the head of pond. thence Branch line 9.87 to
 Beach 3x0 m by Spring, thence N. 12 1/2 W. 6.42 to Chestnut 3x0 m
 thence N. 42 W. 6.09 to small Black Gum 3x3x0 m; thence
