 in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. R. Weatheres

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. R. Weatheres, all that tract or parcel of land situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, all that tract of land having the following metes and bounds, Beginning at a white oak on the banks of the creek near the ford leading to what is known as the Thomas Batt place and running thence S. 30 N. 13 chs. to a cherry now gone but corner well known on this bank of the creek; thence S. 77 E. 10 chs. to a poplar; thence N. 67 3/4 E. 17-84 to a stone 37; thence N. 40 E. 9-50 to a pine 37; thence N. 88 W. 20-00 to a stone 37; thence S. 7 W. 3.50 to the beginning at a white oak corner containing twenty nine and one-half (29 1/2) more or less bounded by J. F. Reese on the west and Martha Neal on the east and others on McBrook creek of Elisha Thompson, Beaver dam creek being the same tract of land deeded to me by J. F. Reese in deed bearing date of 21st. of Jan. 1915 and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County 16th. of Feb. 1915 in Book "B" page 320.
