(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. H. Meadus All that certain lot of land, designated as Lot No. 1 in Block 5, as described on plat of land of the Melville Land Company, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Greenville County, in Plat Book of page 97, above described lot being a part of the sub-division of the land bought by the Melville Land Company from L. B. Bolling, conveyed to W. B. Smith by J. S. Elmore, by deed dated July 4th - 1911 as recorded in R. M. C. office volume 131, page 178 and later conveyed to me by W. B. Smith by deed dated May 5th - 1913 as recorded in R. M. C. volume 131, page 246, and J. V. Smith to Mrs. Nora Smith, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 23, page 1380.
