(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Daisy S. De Mulder - All that piece parcel or lot of land lying and being in the City and County of Greenville in State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a iron pin on the southwest corner of Earle and Wilton Streets and running thence with Earle Street N. 83-13 N. 54-37 feet to a iron pin; thence S. 6-4-7 E. 150 feet to a iron pin; thence S. 83-13 E. 54-37 feet to a iron pin on Wilton Street; thence with Wilton Street N. 6-4-7 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner on Wilton and Earle Streets and being the same lot of land conveyed to us by H. B. Sparkman by deed dated April 24th 1916 and recorded in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Vol. 39 at page 301.
