NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John R. Satterfield of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of love and natural affection which I have for my sister DOLLARS, to M. E. Snyder as well as the sum of five dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the said M. E. Snyder

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said M. E. Snyder. All that five parcel and tract of land containing fifty acres more or less, situate, lying and being in Saville Township, County and State aforesaid, about five miles south of Greenville Court House on both sides of the Stanton Bridge road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3x0m. in a road on the Copper land and running thence S. 5 1/4 N. 21.50 to a poplar 3x0m. struck by lightning and dead at head of a hauch thence down the hauch as a line S. 17 3/4 N. 9.72 to a Sonwood. 3x0m. another hauch. Thence up said hauch as a line to a black oak 3x0m. Thence N. 41.13 E. 17.18 to a Black oak 3x0m. Thence N. 59 1/8 E. 16.29 to a White Oak 3x0m. on Pain's Mill Creek. Thence up the creek as a line about 14.06 to a B. Gum 3x0m. Thence N. 67 1/4 N. 2.00 to a stone 3x0m. Thence S. 83 N. 22.00 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Henry Payne Judge Grace, John Satterfield and others.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

M. E. Snyder, and her heirs and assigns, forever,

AND I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

M. E. Snyder and her heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
