(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. R. Ridgeway, my piece and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, containing eleven and one-half (11-1/2) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake in road and running thence N. 7-1/2 W. 13.45 to a stake, thence S. 56-14 W. 14.78 to a stake, thence S. 42 W. 4.36 to a stake, thence S. 58-1/4 E. 6.93 to road, thence with the road N. 53-7/8 E. 1.11 with road to bend in said road, thence N. 84-1/4 E. 1.23 to bend in said road, thence S. 85 E. 6.14 to the beginning corner, and being a part of the land known as the Coloper plantation near Sandy Springs church and adjoining lands of J. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Wilkins Cagle, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Two (2) of the City of Greenville and in the County of Greenville in the Northern Section of that land, fronting fifty-six feet, eight inches on the West side of the extension of Stone Ave. (now commonly called at that part of the Ave. the Chick's Spring Road). The lot is numbered 33, in the subdivision of the Stone lands, in the plat of the Stone Land Co. and described as being in section 7, with a rear line of sixty-six feet and five inches and with side lines each two hundred and ten feet running back from Stone Ave. The description of said lot, by metes, courses and distances as represented on said Plat, duly recorded in the office of the Register of Mease County for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book 1, at pages 337 and 340, is hereby adopted and made a part of this instrument of conveyance.
