THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W.D. Parrish in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one dollar and love and affection DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W.D. Parrish

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W.D. Parrish, All those certain lots of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, a short distance from the City of Greenville, in the sub-division known as "Paris", being known and designated as lot #7 in Block "A", and lots #9, #10, #18, #19 and #20 in Block "B" as shown on plat of said sub-division recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", at page 87, and being more particularly described as follows: Lot #7, Block "A", Beginning at a stake on the Southeast side of Chick Springs Road, corner of lot #6 and #7, and running thence with the line of lot #6, S. 36-15 E. 39.8 feet to a stake; thence N. 58 E. 25 feet to a stake corner of lots #7 and #8; thence with line of lot #8 N. 36-15 W. 41.6 feet to a stake on Chick Springs Road; thence with said road S. 58-45 W. 25 feet to the beginning corner. Lots #9, #10, #18, #19 and #20, in Block "B", Beginning at a stake on the Northwest side of Chick Springs Road, corner Lots #8 and #9, and running thence with said Chick Springs Road S. 58-45 W. 200 feet to a stake, corner of lots #10 and #11; thence with line of lot #11, N. 36-30 W. 178 feet to stake joint corner of Lots #11, #10, #18 and #19; thence S. 61-45 W. 20 feet to corner of lots #11, #12-17 and #18; thence with line common to #17 and #18 N. 49-10 W. 212 feet to a stake on or near the right-of-way of Greenville, Spartanburg & Anderson Railway Company; thence N. 70-15 E. 300 feet to stake joint corner of lots #20 and #21; thence with line common to lots #20 and #21, S. 30-15 E. 155 feet to a stake; thence with line common to lots #8 and #9, S. 36-30 E. 151 feet to the beginning corner.
