This Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into this 13th, day of August 1919 by and between T.F. Hunt and H.L. Todd, of the first part and O.L. Ayers, of the second part, Witnesseth:-That for and in consideration of the sum of eighty-four hundred dollars (\$400.00), payable as hereinafter stated, T.F. Hunt and H.L. Todd agree to convey to O.L. Ayers by fee simple title with full warranty a certain tract of land in Chick Springs Township, containing thirty acres, more or less, in the State and County aforesaid, being fully described in the deed of Geo. J. Douglass and J.Lee Green to W.T. Henderson, T.F. Hunt and H.L. Todd, recorded in Book 34, page 360.

0.L. Avers agrees to pay one thousand dollars in cash upon the execution of this agreement for the Purpose of binding the trade, and which amount shall be considered as part payment of the eightyfour hundred dollars purchase price. The remaining \$7400.00 shall be paid by the said 0.L. Ayers fifteen hundred dollars in cash on or before January 1st, 1920, at which time the said T.F. Hunt and H.L. Todd shall execute to O.L.
