Ellie Oglesby, All that certain lot of land lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and having the following bounds: Beginning at a stake on Bob Street at the corner of Mattie Chappell's lot; thence with her line 100 feet to a stake; thence 45 feet to Mollie Simpson's line; thence with Mollie Simpson's line 100 feet to a stake on Bob Street; thence 45 feet along Bob Street to beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by W.T. Eddings by deed dated August 27, 1919 and recorded in Book 49, page 100.

Putman, All that certain piece, parcel of lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the City of Greenville on Endel Street; and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Endel Street and running thence with Molly Simpson's line S. 68-5 E. 153 feet to a stake; thence 45 feet to a stake on line of Mattie Chappell; thence N. 68-5 W. 93 along the line of Mattie Chappel to a stake on Endel Street; thence S. 59 W. 53 feet to the beginning corner; being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Olive A.
