(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*John S. Taylor* All that piece, parcel or lot of land containing Seven Thousand (7,000) square feet more or less, situated, lying and being in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville and the County and State aforesaid, at the North East corner of Markley and Pett Streets, and having the following lines and bounds to-wit: Beginning at the corner of said streets and running thence with North side of Pett Street N. 70 1/2 E. One hundred (100) feet more or less, to a iron post 3 x 4, thence N. 18 1/4 E. Seventy (70) feet more or less to an iron post 3 x 4, on M<sup>o</sup> Hughes' line. Thence S. 70 1/2 W. one hundred (100) feet more or less to an iron post 3 x 4 on Markley Street, thence along east side of said Markley Street S. 18 3/4 E.
