(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. T. Graydon his heirs and assigns, all that piece,  
or parcel of land lying and being in the County  
& State above and near the town of Simpsonville and  
having the following metes and bounds to wit:  
Beginning on a Stake at road thence N. 18<sup>34</sup> W. 5.26  
chains to Stake - thence S. 71- W. 5.75 chains to a  
block at branch, thence along said branch 2.60  
chains to a Willow, thence S. 78 E. 1.10 Black Gum  
on branch - thence up said branch S. 83 E. 5.46 chains  
to a bridge at road - thence along said road N.  
44<sup>34</sup> E. 3.85 chains to a stone thence N. 64 E. 1.88  
chains to the beginning corner bounded by  
lands of J. H. Putnam, Mrs Louise Burdette
