(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Bessie L. Todd, all that lot or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid on the South side of Gilder's Creek, being a part of the land bought by J. D. Leonard from J. Thomas Austin, March 18th, 1886, known as the Austin Place, recorded in Book "RR", page 626:
