in the County andin the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Eighty Thousand (\$16,000) DOLLARS,
to said C. Godfrey Webster, in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by C. Godfrey Webster, of the County and State
aforesaid(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
C. Godfrey Webster, all that piece parcel of lot of land
situate, lying and being in and near 2nd Street, the City of
Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, being
known as lot #109, in Block C, of East Park part of Boyce
Addition to Greenville, S.C., and having a frontage on
Gipsey Avenue of fifty feet and running back to a depth of
14½ feet on one side and 14¾ feet on the other side
and is fifty feet wide in the rear, on a slight incline, on which
alley, which is ten feet wide, the said lot bounded in the
rear. This lot is the same which was conveyed to
