KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Charlotte R. Smith

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Twenty Federal Hundred DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by D. P. Montgomery

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

D. P. Montgomery, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated on the South east side of Mulberry Street in Ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and known as a part of lot #15 of the real estate of S. P. Rutledge deceased and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the South east side of Mulberry Street, five feet north east of the corner of lot #6, and approximately 208-3/4 feet north east of Parkney Street and running thence with said Mulberry Street, N. 56-3/4 E. 55 feet to a stake; corner of lot #4; thence with line of lot #4 S. 33-1/4 E. 132 feet, thence S. 57-1/2 E. 52 feet, thence in a northwesterly direction approximately 13-1/2 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. D. Parrish and J. C. Kowen by Deed dated December 8th 1915, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Volume 36, page 191.
The grantor herein agreed to pay the City taxes on this property for the year 1918, and she guarantees to pay the State and County taxes for this year. She agreed also to pay all other taxes or pending assessments against said property.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said D. P. Montgomery, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said D. P. Montgomery, his heirs and assigns, against all and singular, the heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
