(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Florence J. Hendrix and Fannie E. Cooper, all that
certain lot of land situate in South Carolina's Greenville
County about two miles north of Greenville Count
House, being lot number fifteen (15) of block A of
Riverside by subdivision of land represented on a
plat in plat book A page 323, said lot had the
following metes and bounds: Beginning 100 feet
east off Green street on the north side of Cedar
Lane Road at corner of lot number 14, and running
thence west the Cedar Lane Road 879-57 E. fifty feet
to corner of lot 16; thence parallel with Green street
W. E. one hundred twenty-five feet to an alley;
thence with the alley W. 79-57 N. fifty feet to
corner of lot 14; thence parallel with Green street
one hundred twenty-five feet to the beginning
corners and being the same lot contained total area by
Riverside Land Company deed recorded in the R. M.
C. office for said Greenville County as Deed
