Mr. Warren Lipscombe, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain lot of land situate lying  
and being in the County and State aforesaid  
and being known as lot No. 7 in Block 11, as  
shown on plat recorded in Deed Book  
P.O.P. page 115 and lying on the South side  
of Mc Bee Boulevard and having the following  
streets and bounds to wit: beginning at the  
corner of lot No. 5; thence with Mc Bee Boulevard  
N. 39° 00' forty-nine (49) feet and eleven (11)  
inches to corner of lot No. 9; thence with the  
line of lot No. 9 S. 50° 10' W. One hundred and  
seventy-nine (179) feet to corner of lot No.
