KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we H. L. McCall, D. D. McCall Jr and D. H. McCall, Executors of the Will of D. D. McCall, deceased, of the County of Marlboro.

in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by D. D. McCall, as Trustee of the County of Marlboro

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

D. D. McCall, as Trustee;

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situated lying and being within the corporate limits of the City of Summerville and the County of Marlboro and being the following (metes and bounds), Beginning at a Iron Pin at Hammonds Street and running thence South 36 degrees 4 minutes East 100 feet to a Iron Pin on said street; thence North 38 degrees 55 minutes East 191.6 to a Iron Pin on a unnamed Street; thence with said unnamed Street North 30 degrees 30 minutes West 103.4 feet to a Iron Pin; thence South 38 degrees 55 minutes West 204.4 feet to the beginning corner.

For a more particular description reference is directed to a Blue Print made by E. H. McCallough July 29th - 1904, being the same lot of land conveyed to D. D. McCall, deceased, by the City National Bank the 9th day of October, 1906, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances of Summerville County, in said State, October 17th, 1906, in Book 587, page 5.

This deed is made by the Executors of the last will and testament of D. D. McCall, deceased, who, under the terms of said will, have complete power and authority to convey this lot of land.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said D. D. McCall as trustee, his Successors

and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said D. D. McCall, as Trustee, his Successors

and assigns, against

us and all other persons heirs, and lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
