KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *W B H Earle, J H Earle, Wm C H Earle, John H Earle, Mary E Rice, James Birnie, Lucia E Crawford, William E Montgomery and Hilton H Earle* heirs of the estate of *J H Earle*, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *Twenty one Thousand* DOLLARS, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *Charles McAlister*,

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said *Charles McAlister*,

heirs and assigns, forever.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *Charles McAlister*, all of our interest or claim to the following described piece of property, all that certain piece parcel land lot of land situate lying and being east the County and State aforesaid, Beginning at a stake on the Gilbert Shoals road and running thence N. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 12.50 to an oak stake, thence N. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 42.80 to a stone, thence N. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 18.10 to a post oak, thence S. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 26.50 to a stone, thence N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 16.75 to a Poplar, thence S. 21 E. 20.86 to a sugar gum, thence S. 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 2.50 to a stone, thence S. 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18.35 to a stake on the Gilbert Shoals road, thence with said road S. 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.95 to the beginning corner, containing eighty-four (84) acres more or less.
