KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. H. Nangetta

In the State aforesaid,

Four Hundred (\$400) DOLLARS,
to me In hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by
W. W. Putman

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. W. Putman, his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Greenville Township, in the Town of West Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a corner of Inman and Endel streets and running thence n. 61 E. with Endel St. 45 ft., thence n. 30 W. 100 ft., thence S. 61 W. 45 ft. to Inman St., thence with Inman St. S. 30 E. 100 ft. to the beginning corner, being Lot #3 of the survey of the Mollie Simpson property. See Plat Book "A", page 369, R. M. L. Office for said County. This being the same lot of land conveyed to J. H. Nangetta by J. Frank Eppes, see Vol. 41, page 227, R. M. H. Office.
