Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Forty Eight Hundred (\$4800.00) Dollars,  
to me paid by the said J.P. Jordan

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said J.P. Jordan the following described real estate

to-wit: All that certain piece parcel or tract of land  
situated in the State and County aforesaid, in Orkeley  
Township, containing 80 1/2 Acres, more or less, and being  
known and designated as tract No. 3, of the Clarence  
Engum Wass lands according to a subdivision and plat  
of same made by Wm. F. Lee Surveyor on September  
25-28 and 30th, 1918, and having the following  
metes and bounds and courses and distances as follows.  
Beginning at a rock 130m in or near road, and  
running thence N. 15 1/2 E. 35.40 to rock 130m
