Holland, of the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, All my undivided interest, right, title & claim I, in, or to all that piece, parcel, tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, Austin Township State of South Carolina on waters of Bridge Fork Creek waters of Kilders Creek, Water of Snow River, and more particularly described in a plat made by H.
