DEED TO Herbert G. Smith

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That W. D. Parish and T. C. Gower  
of the City of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
Seventeen Hundred and Fifty (\$1750.00) Dollars DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Herbert G. Smith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said Herbert G. Smith, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, just without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the East side of Augusta Road, known and designated as lot No. 9, as shown on plat of property of Parish & Gower, by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated May 1919, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. E page 136 and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on Augusta Road 735.3 feet from the intersection of Augusta Street and Crescent Avenue joint corner of lots Nos. 8 and 9, and running thence along line of lot No. 8 N. 42-57 E. 173 feet to an iron pipe; thence still with line of lot No. 8 N. 41-24 E. 54 feet to an iron pipe on a 15 foot alley; thence with said alley S. 56-28 E. 60 feet to an iron pipe joint corner of lots Nos. 8 and 10; thence with line of lot No. 10 S. 40-55 W. 65.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence still with line of lot No. 10 S. 42-50 W. 173 feet to an iron pipe on Augusta Road; thence with Augusta Road N. 47-53 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning subject, however to the following restrictions, which are part of the consideration for this deed and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on plat above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date of this instrument: (1) The property herein conveyed, shall any part thereof shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes. (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor for any thing which would constitute a nuisance. (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be cut nor subdivided so as to face any other direction than is shown on said plat. (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within thirty-five feet of the private line of Augusta Street. (5) No building costing less than Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars shall be erected upon said lot, other than out buildings appurtenant to the dwelling.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Herbert G. Smith, his heirs and assigns, forever,

ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Herbert G. Smith, his
