Roe, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being on the East side of Mulberry St. in Ward 1 in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Mulberry St. corner of lot no. 3 of the L. J. Jennings property and running thence along Mulberry St. N. 74.57° E. 45 feet to iron pin corner of lot no. 5, thence with line of lot no. 5 S. 82.03° E. 138.3 feet or to iron pin on Piedmont Avenue, thence along Piedmont Avenue S. 59.07° W. 45 feet to iron pin corner of lot no. 3, thence with line of lot no. 3 N. 32.03° W. 137 feet to the beginning corner, and being known and designated as lot no. 4 as shown on plat made by P.
