to Duff Putnam  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Duff Putnam

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said  
Duff Putnam all that tract of land situate in  
the County and State aforesaid, on both sides of  
Lotterville Beaverdam Creek, having the following  
metes and bounds: Beginning on a Post Oak stump  
and run thence S. 63° 4' W. 13.06 chrs. to a stone

thence N. 74 1/2 E. 22.31 chrs. to a stake or stone thence  
N. 33 1/2 W. 28.24 chrs. to a stone 32' thence S. 39 3/4 N. 3.90 chrs.
