(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Gertrude L. Lipscombe, One undivided one-half interest in All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward One of the City of Greenville, said State aforesaid, on Washington Street being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on south side of said street, at the corner of lot conveyed by Morgan and Austin to Mary A. Waddell and running thence N. 40° E. three hundred and thirty (330) feet to a stake on John Street; thence with John Street N. 50° W. Sixty-Six (66) feet to a stake; thence S. 40° W. three hundred forty (340) feet to Washington Street; thence with said Washington Street S. 65° E. Sixty-Six (66) feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to D. M. Castner, by Minnie M. Castner (formerly Logan) by her deed dated May 29-1911, recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in book 13 page 30 being the same lot of land conveyed to Alice L. Guinn and Ella Little - by D. M. Castner, by deed dated October 5, 1910 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book 13 page 501.
