(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. J. Glasgow, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, inside the city limits of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: - Beginning at an iron pin on Albert Street and runs thence N. 89-30 E. 109.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 12-48 W. 60 feet; thence S. 50-30 W. to said Albert Street; thence S. 9-30 E. 60 ft. to the beginning corner.

Also all that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, inside the limits of the town of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of Albert and Marchant Streets and running thence S. 09-30 E. 138 feet to a stake on Albert Street; thence N. 40-30 E. 109 feet to a stake on bank of branch; thence with said branch N. 12-48 W. 97.2 feet to a stake; thence N. 43-21 W. 38.1 feet to a stake; thence N. 43-47 W. 24.5 feet to a stake on Marchant Street; thence with Marchant Street N. 88-30 E. 57 feet to the beginning corner, where stakes are on the bank of Branch, the center of branch is the Eastern line, increasing these dimensions approximately five feet.

Also all that certain other piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and being in the limits of the town of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: - Beginning at a point on Marchant Street and runs thence with said Marchant Street 60 feet to Hack's line; thence along Hack's line 20 to the Oil mill Spring Branch; thence with the meanders of said branch 66 feet to the beginning corner.
