(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

E. Land, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel or
tract of land situate, in Dunklin Township, Greenville
County, S.C. containing 118 1/2 acres, more or less.

Beginning at a stone near an ash, at the junction
of a branch with Horse Creek at the corner of tract
number two of W.M. Ridgeway land and running thence
N. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 12.00 to a point on branch, thence N. 77 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.86 up
said branch, thence N. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.00 to a stone, thence N. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$
E. 8.72 to a stone on old road, thence N. 47 W. 6.07 to a stone,
thence N. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.00 to a point on gully, thence N. 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.79
to end of branch, thence N. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.86 to a point on branch,
thence N. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.86 to a cherry on branch, thence N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.
to a stone, at the junction of the branch, thence along
the branch at a line N. 48 W. 13.80 to a point on line of
William Simms land, thence N. 52 3/4 W. 19.12 along Simms
line to a stone on Lebanon Cemetery land, thence S.
33 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 23.84 to a stone, thence S. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 21.40 to Horse Creek, thence
S. 17.50 E. 19.20 along Horse Creek as a line to the beginning
corner and being the same tract of land conveyed
to W.D. Ridgeway by W.M. Ridgeway, Oct. 31st, 1916; deed
recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in
Vol. H1 at page 295, and being conveyed to me by the
said W.D. Ridgeway in two separate deeds one dated
Nov. 11th, 1916, and recorded in Vol. H1 at page 344; the
other dated Dec. 8th, 1916, and recorded in Vol. H3 at page
11. Also that other piece, parcel or tract of land, situate,
lying and being in Dunklin Township, Greenville
County, South Carolina, near Lebanon Church, and
being a part of lands formerly owned by W.A. Black,
and containing 14-1/4/100 acres, more or less;

thence N. 70 W. 12.67 to a point in the Dunklin Bridge Road
on the north side of said road, thence N. 70 W. 12.67 to a point in the
Horse Creek Road, thence N. 70 W. 12.67 to a point near the forks of road said
point being in the Dunklin Bridge broad, and 16 links
from stake on the south side of road, thence S. 37.50 W.
4.77 along road to the beginning point, and being the
same land conveyed to me by W.M. Ridgeway Feb. 19, 1918;
