DEED TO J. F. White

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

We, W. A. Page and J. M. Page, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Five Dollars and other Valuable Considerations DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by J. F. White

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. F. White, his heirs and assigns forever: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, known as lot number 8 in Block "D" having such metes and bounds, courses and distances as will appear by reference to plat of land of City View Land Company made by F. S. Rogers and recorded in R. M. C. office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "A" at page 327, being part of the land conveyed to W. J. Henderson and J. F. Hunt by the City View Land Company by deed bearing date of Jan. 29th. 1918 and recorded in Vol. 8, page 428.

Also all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate lying and being in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, and known as lot number 9 of Block "D" on plat and survey of said land made by F. S. Rogers C. E. and recorded in R. M. C. office for the County and State aforesaid and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a corner on Summit Street and running back parallel with lot No. 3, 55 feet to lot No. 10; thence parallel with lot No. 10, 207 feet to Summit Street, thence parallel with Summit Street, 55 feet to the beginning corner, being the same two lots of land conveyed to us by J. F. White by deed dated March 20th. 1919 and recorded in Vol. 44 at page 443.

It is understood and agreed as a part of the consideration herein above expressed that the said J. F. White is to assume and pay a certain promissory note, and a mortgage bearing the same, executed by W. A. Page and J. M. Page in the sum of \$2100.00, dated March, 20th. 1919, together with interest on the said amount from Aug. 22, 1919 until paid.
