KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Joseph M. C. Bulloughs

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Ten and no/100 Dollars and other good and valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by W. T. Henderson and W. O. Allen, both of
Greenville S.C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

W. T. Henderson and W. O. Allen, and their heirs and assigns,
All those two (2) certain pieces, parcels or lots of land
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
And County and City of Greenville, in the 4th Ward of
said City, fronting the main line of the W. & W. Rail Road
and having together the following Bmetes and bounds
according to a plat made by P. C. Dalton, Engn. July 1916
to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on Hunter - Wilson
Lumber Co's line (said iron pipe being about 27.5' feet
from the main line of said Railway) and running thence
N. 71-55 W. 103.2' to iron pipe on Thos. Davis line; thence
along said line N. 18-42 E. 135.5' to iron pipe; thence S. 73-28
E. 142.4' to an iron pipe on line of property of Hunter - Wilson
Lumber Co.; thence along said line S. 34-46 W. 141.7' to the
beginning corner, and known as Lots #1-a and 3-a
