 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Lee Greene

in consideration of the sum of
Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
 to mein hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by A. J. Douglass

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

A. J. Douglass, his heirs and assigns, all of my undivided one half interest of, in and to all that lot of land, situate in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, on the North side of Buncombe Street, beginning at an iron pin on Buncombe Street at W. J. Fournille's corner, and running thence with Fournille's line N 57° E 186 feet to an iron pin on lot formerly belonging to J. S. Maxwell; thence with line of said Maxwell lot N 24° W 70-1/3 feet to an iron pin on J. Alton's line; thence S 57° W 194 feet to an iron pin on Buncombe Street; thence with Buncombe Street S. 33 3/4° E 70 feet to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to myself and said Douglass by W. H. Ballentine, by deed dated the 10th day of January, 1918, and recorded in Vol. 50, page 12.

As a part of the consideration of this deed, the grantee herein does hereby assume and will pay a certain note and mortgage for Twenty five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00), with all interest that may accrue thereon from the 15th day of February, 1919, the same having been given by W. H. Ballentine to C. H. Godshaw the 20th day of June, 1917, mortgage recorded in Vol. 61, page 43.
