KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

The J. B. Rasor and W. L. Rasor

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable Considerations DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by L. A. Hobbs and W. T. Henderson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

L. A. Hobbs and W. T. Henderson, All that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the third Ward of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat thereof made by F. S. Rogers, dated September 7, 1909, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the West side of South Main Street, one hundred and seventeen (117) feet and seven (7) inches southward from the South West corner of Main and Broad Streets, and running thence southward along said Main Street sixty two (62) feet to an iron pin on the North East corner of the lot conveyed by Sarah R. Davidson to R. N. and J. A. Tannahill; thence turning to the right by an angle of 90 degrees, and running westward and parallel with Broad Street, along the line of the said Tannahill lot, one hundred seventy (170) feet to stake on the North West corner of said Tannahill lot, and on the East side of an alley eleven (11) feet and three (3) inches wide, which opens into Marpley Alley on the South; thence running to the right by an angle of ninety (90) degrees and running along the East side of the Alley first above mentioned, Northward and parallel with Main Street sixty two (62) feet to an iron pin on the corner of said Alley and another alley which opens into Jackson Street; thence turning to the right by an angle of ninety (90) degrees, and running eastward and parallel with Broad Street along the South side of the Alley last mentioned and along the South side of the lot of land conveyed by Sarah R. Davidson to S. E. Bradshaw et al. one hundred seventy (170) feet to the beginning corner being the same lot conveyed to us by W. D. Jarvis, J. B. Lower, F. W. Symmes, L. A. Hobbs and L. A. Miller, by deed dated July 3, 1914, by deed duly recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 27 page 137.
