 at and before the sealing of these presents by *W. R. Blakely*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

W. R. Blakely, all those two lots of land lying and being situated in Greenville County and State of South Carolina, known as lots Nos. 24 and 25 Block "C" of the old Scruggs Survey, said lots lying just outside of the two of Fountain Inn to the east, and bounded by lands of Percy Putman, other lands of the said Joe Long and being the same conveyed to Joe Long by Ophelia Long by Deed dated December 30th, 1910, and recorded in Book 20 at page 483 in the office of the Greenville County, also two other certain lots of land adjoining the other said lots and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, and known and designated as lots 22 and 23 in Block "C" of the old Scruggs Survey, the said lots having frontage on Cherry Street of one hundred and twenty five feet, and being bounded by Lots of said R. W. Davis, P. J. Putman and others.
