We, L. A. Stuart, Julia E. Shumate, Ella Bass, Maggie Hasley, Lena Miller, Mary A. Stuart, sole heirs at law of Thomas C. Stuart, dead, of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,

Five Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by W. F. Bull of the County and State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

W. F. Bull, his heirs and assigns, all our right, title, interest and estate of, in and to all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina on West Washington Street, and hath the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on said Washington Street, corner of lot formerly belonging to W. C. McKenzie thence N. fifty feet (50) with Washington Street to an iron pin on line of Mrs. Julia E. Shumate, thence N. one hundred sixty seven and one half feet (167 1/2) to a line on lot formerly owned by Mary A. Stuart; thence S. fifty feet (50) feet to a line on lot formerly owned by W. C. McKenzie and thence with said line one hundred sixty seven and one half feet (167 1/2) feet to the beginning corner being part of the lot conveyed by Davis C. Dunham to Thomas C. Stuart, Mary A. Stuart, and Julia E. Shumate. See vol. B. G. G. page 703 and conveyed by Mary A. Stuart and Mrs. Julia E. Shumate to Thomas C. Stuart, and inherited by us from said Thomas C. Stuart now dead, as his only heirs at law.
